




## SHORT REVIEW...

## MIRRORS - ROUND AND SQUARE

**John Lucas from American Association for Woodturning** makes a lot of hand mirrors - **this YouTube video** gives useful hints and tips on dealing with problems of wood movement, fixing a handle into the round body of the mirror and the best way of attaching a mirror in place.



Having become fascinated with square platters and with a scrap box full of small pieces, John experimented with turned forms that started out as squares, and decided they would be perfect stock for hand mirrors. Turning these hand mirrors has been a great deal of fun and the size

keeps the cost down, so he can afford to play with shape, color, texture, and design. Read **this article** about how he does it (plenty of useful information about using waste blocks with paper joints).
