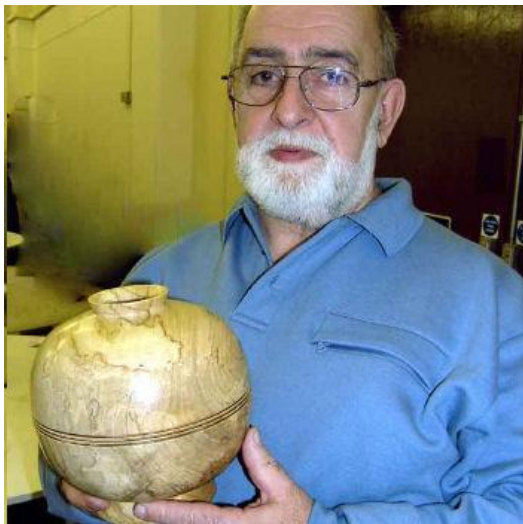


Annual General Meeting plus Frank Clarke Prize - February 2007

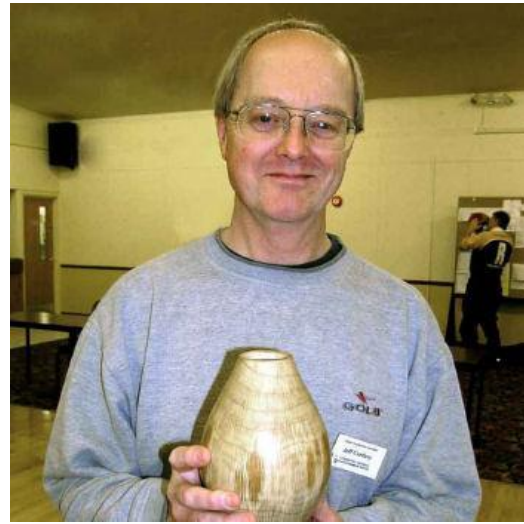
